CONDITIONS: This permit is hereby granted with the understanding that the contractor shall work in accordance with plans and specifications; and that all general and detail work connected with such installation, alteration, or repair of any such plumbing shall be done in strict compliance with the ordinances of the Village of Palos Park, Illinois.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Special Assessments or Tap-In Fees are paid to date.
2. Plumbers Cash Bond of \$500.00 posted at time of permit application. Cash Bond is refundable upon project completion.
3. Submit an annotated Plat of Survey or Site Plan showing dimensions and location of proposed service line with permit application. A Residential Water Supply and Meter Size Requirements Table must be completed by the licensed plumber and submitted with permit application. Please indicate the location of any well.
4. MXU-Reading device requires 1/2" conduit from meter to flush with outside with 3 or 4 conductor phone line wire is to be installed before completion of home.
5. Utility Billing fees begin the day the meter is issued. If the owner listed is not the recipient of the bill please notify the Utility Department 708-671-3716.
6. All water line connections must be flared coupling or compression fittings.
7. RPZ is required for any potential pollution sources. No cross connection allowed between well and city water.

PLUMBING INSPECTION: It is required that the plumbing contractor shall have completed the roughing-in of the plumbing and shall have tested his work before requiring the plumbing inspection. The request for inspection should be made at least 48 hours in advance of such requested inspection. Should it be necessary for a re-inspection by reason of incomplete or rejected work, a fee of \$50.00 shall be charged for such added inspection; such fee to be paid to the Village Collector.

****NOTE**** Construction water is usable only on foundation and shell of home. Once house has walls and heat the meter must be installed and inspected. Utility Bills will begin upon installation.

Plumber’s Letter of Intent – must accompany application at submittal

The State of Illinois requires plumbers provide a Letter of Intent to the Village for each plumbing job. This is a relatively new regulation that the State mandates all Villages to follow. (See Illinois State Statutes, Chapter 111)

The Letter of Intent should contain the following information on the plumbing company’s stationary:

- Name of the plumbing company, address, telephone, fax, e-mail, and website
- Type of company – sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or LLC
- Corporate seal (for plumbing companies that are corporations)
- Address of the job site that matches the address on the building permit application
- Name of each licensed plumber that would be working on the job site
- License number of each plumber
- Notarized signature of each plumber
