All senior citizens (sixty-five years of age or older as of July 1) shall be entitled to purchase one passenger motor vehicle license at one-half the normal license fee and one antique motor vehicle license at one-half the normal license fee upon presentation of proof of age and registration (limit of two of each license per household). In addition, senior citizens utilizing a truck (gross weight up to 8,000 pounds) as their primary mode of personal transportation shall be entitled to purchase motor vehicle licenses (one per senior citizen, with a limit of two per household) for trucks, (gross weight up to 8,000 pounds) at one-half the normal license fee. At the time of purchase, the senior citizen requesting the discounted rate shall certify the truck is used for personal transportation and is never used in business or commercial pursuits.

Late payments made on or after July 1st of fee year \$ 50.00

Transfers

A resident may transfer a vehicle sticker from the original vehicle to the new vehicle, as long as the original vehicle is no longer in the resident's possession (sold/traded/destroyed/junked). A transfer sticker may be purchased for \$5.00 with either the current sticker receipt or a portion of the old sticker.

Inspections

The fee for a building inspection, other than a plumbing or electrical inspection, shall be seventy-five dollars (\$75.00). The fee for a plumbing or electrical inspection shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00). When a re-inspection is required, due to the previous inspection not being approved by the Village, the fees shall be one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00).

Water

Customer Rates for General Water Use:

Effective November 1, 2019 and thereafter, twelve dollars and thirty-six cents (\$12.36) per 1,000 gallons of water supplied.

*Beginning October 1, 2008, in addition to the forgoing water consumption rates, a water system capital improvements fee of six dollars and fifty cents (\$6.50) per month shall be charged to each water account.

Minimum Charges:

Effective November 1, 2019 and thereafter, forty-three dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$43.58) per month.

The business of distributing, supplying, furnishing or selling **gas** for consumption in the Village, and not for resale, at the rate of **five percent (5%)** of the gross receipts therefrom.

The business of distributing, supplying, furnishing or selling **electricity** for consumption in the Village, and not for resale, at the rate of **five percent (5%)** of the gross receipts therefrom.

Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax

A simplified municipal telecommunications tax is hereby imposed pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax Act, codified at ILCS Ch. 35, Act 636 5-1, et seq., as it is amended from time to time, at a rate of **six percent (6%)**.

Municipal Electric Utility Tax

See Code Section 892.02

Pursuant to Section 8-11-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65ILCS 5/8-11-2) and any and all other applicable authority, a tax is imposed upon the privilege of using or consuming electricity acquired in a purchase at retail and used or consumed within the corporate limits of the Village at the following rates, calculated on a monthly basis for each purchaser.

Tax on the Gross Receipts of Places for Eating

There is hereby levied and imposed upon owners of places for eating a tax at the rate of **two percent (2%)** of gross receipts received for prepared food sold at retail by the owner on or after December 1, 2009.

Amusement Tax

A tax is hereby imposed upon all persons operating amusements within the corporate limits of the Village, and upon all persons operating places which provide amusements within corporate limits of the Village, in an amount equal to **three percent (3%)** of the gross receipts for each amusement. Said tax shall be in addition to all other taxes imposed by law.
