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Application for HISTORIC MARKER

The purpose of this program is to promote the awareness, appreciation, and pride in homes and other buildings, structures, and sites that contribute to the historic heritage and character of the Village and are at a second level of significance to Landmarks which are at the highest level of significance.

This Application Form is to be filled out and returned to the Finance Department for all proposed Historic Marker designations. Upon receipt of this application and related documentation, the Finance Department will schedule a review at the next available meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission. Upon a vote of approval by the HPC, the Village will issue a Historic Marker to be posted on the property.

There is no fee for this application. Criteria for designation and other regulations for this program are in Section 1499 of the Village Code. All codes, forms, maps, meeting agendas, and minutes are available on the Village website, at the Kaptur Administrative Center at the address above, by fax, or by email.

Everyone is encouraged to contact Finance Department staff for assistance. We hope to make this process as clear as possible. Thank you for your efforts to preserve the historic character of Palos Park.

1. **Age:** at least 50 years old – such as proof of ownership, deed, plat of survey, other evidence;
2. **Significance:** prominent owner, occupant, event, architect, style – such as title records, Granacki report, historian notes, photos, or other evidence;
3. **Condition:** currently preserved, well-maintained, or altered in a way that is compatible with original style and detail – photos, drawings, inspection by Village, or other evidence.

PLEDGE

If a Historic Marker is approved, we ask that the Owner post the Marker on site in public view from the street, to make reasonable effort to maintain said Marker, and to return the Marker to the Village if the Historic Marker designation is ever removed.
