_____ Twelve pick-up dates similar to 2009 schedule.

_____ On an as-needed basis, by telephoning Public Works to schedule on the next pick-up date.

_____ The Village should not offer a Chipping Service, and residents should utilize the free pick up of yard waste through the Refuse Collection Contractor Allied Waste.

The amount of branches that could be left for chipping is a pile no larger than 4 feet high and 10 feet in length, with a maximum time limit of 20 minutes per property.

2. Please circle the volume of branches typically placed out for pick up in 2009.

Large pile 4 ft x 6 ft

Medium pile 3 ft x 4 ft

Small pile 2 ft x 2 ft
