The Village of Palos Park uses a commercial tree nursery to supply trees, availability depends on stock at the time of our order. Please be prepared to have an alternate choice available. Trees in our area are being replaced rapidly due to the infestation of the Emerald Ash Borer and other tree issues.

Our supplier has warned that certain tree species may sell out.

We encourage you to research your tree before making a choice. Things to consider are the type of climate the tree needs, watering conditions, leaf, if it bears fruit or blossoms, color, etc. to make the best choice for in front of your home.
