

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FOR
NONRESIDENTS USE OF SWIMMING POOL FACILITIES**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 3rd day of April, 2008 by and between the City of Palos Heights, an Illinois Municipal corporation (hereafter referred to as "City") and the Village of Palos Park, an Illinois Municipal corporation (hereafter referred to as "Municipal Partner") under authority of Section Ten (10) of Article VII of the Illinois State Constitution and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5ILCS 220/1 et seq.)

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a swimming pool and related facilities located at 7650 W. College Drive;

WHEREAS, the City sells both annual fee membership and daily use passes to the public to allow the use of the facilities;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City wishes to extend membership to residents of neighboring governmental units; and

WHEREAS, neighboring governmental units have expressed an interest in allowing and providing their residents an opportunity to utilize the City's facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. The City shall allow residents of the Palos Park to purchase annual memberships to utilize the swimming pool facilities located at 7650 W. College Drive under its Municipal Benefit Program. Said membership shall be purchased from each Municipal Partner.

2. The Municipal Benefit Program of the City is set forth herein:

Benefits of Partnership/Membership Privileges

- Offers your residents an opportunity to obtain membership at a reduced rate.
- Reduced rate for swim lesson programming.
- Outdoor swimming in 50 meter pool.
- Complementary passes.
- Special Event Programming: Wacky Wednesdays & Family Fridays (Cookout Nights)

- \$200.00 preseason price on family pass of four if purchased by Friday, May 23rd.

- \$230.00 season price on family pass of four if purchased after May 23rd.

Individual

- \$85.00 preseason price on individual pass if purchased by Friday, May 23rd.

Senior

- \$65.00 preseason price on senior pass if purchased by Friday, May 23rd.
- \$90.00 season price on senior pass if purchased after May 23rd.

- Municipal Partnership Individuals or Seniors receive 1 complementary pass.
- Swim Lessons are \$35 for members.

- Monday-Friday, Open Swim Noon-7:00 p.m.
- Saturday-Sunday, Open Swim 11:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Private Pool Rentals Saturday-Sunday 5:30-7:30 p.m.
- Holiday Hours 11:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (July 3rd & 4th).

3. Each Municipal Partner shall be authorized to add a \$10.00 administrative fee to the cost of membership to cover their costs.

4. Upon proper proof of personal identification and residency in the Village of Palos Park the City shall sell an annual membership for the use of its facilities to the applicant.

5. Purchaser shall be responsible for obeying and following all rules and regulations established by the City for the use of its facilities.

6. The "Village of Palos Park" shall advertise and promote the opportunity to its residents to participate in the Municipal Benefits Program of the City.

7. **Counterpart Execution.** This Agreement may be executed in duplicate originals or in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if all parties hereto have executed the same document. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall

constitute one agreement. This Agreement does not take effect until executed by all parties.
